

Adam's Mothers!

KJV Genesis 3:20 And Adam called his wife's name Eve; because she was the mother of all living.

Eve is the **first mother** of all human beings! Mother means “**point of departure**.”

In order to **legally** enter the realm of the humans one has to **depart** from a woman.

The Serpent knew this so he goes after Eve to deceive her and cause her children to enter the earth contaminated by deception!

NIV Genesis 3:6 When the woman saw that the fruit of the tree was good for food and pleasing to the eye, and also desirable for gaining wisdom, she took some and ate it. She also gave some to her husband, who was with her, and he ate it.

[The first Adam didn't have a mother to teach him about women!](#)

The first woman in his life was Eve who blew his mind—she had to be something to get him to disobey God.

1 Tim 2:14 says Adam was not deceived! He knew exactly what he was doing—Eve blew his mind! **So what kind of mother you think she'll be?**

KJV Proverbs 14:1 Every wise woman buildeth her house: but the foolish plucketh it down with her hands.

A wise woman is one who knows God and uses His Word as the foundation for building relationships with her husband, children and everything needed to build a successful household.

KJV Proverbs 5:3 For the lips of a strange woman drop as an honeycomb, and her mouth is smoother than oil:

A strange woman is **not** just a prostitute; they are women who don't know God or His Word! God's way of doing things seems strange to them.

The **first mother** didn't realize how blessed she was, being the mother of all human beings—she wanted more!

The **mother of Jesus** (The Last Adam) had an angel appear to her:

.... Hail, thou that art highly favoured, the Lord is with thee: blessed art thou among women. (Luke 1:28)

The Bible says Mary was greatly troubled by what the angel said to her!
She tried to discern and understand what all this meant!

The Mother of The Last Adam was wise and discerning, she didn't let her emotions get the best of her!

Luke 1:30-35 And the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God.

31 And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus.

32 He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. And the Lord God will give to him the throne of his father David,

33 and he will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of his kingdom there will be no end."

34 And Mary said to the angel, "How will this be, since I am a virgin?"

35 And the angel answered her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; therefore the child to be born will be called holy- the Son of God.

KJV Luke 1:38 And Mary said, Behold the handmaid of the Lord; be it unto me according to thy word.

Mary **mother of The Last Adam** said look I am the servant of The LORD let it be just as God wills in my life!

The first mother wasn't satisfied being the first women, wife and mother she wanted more and allowed deception to build her house!

But the mother of Jesus humbled herself and allowed The Word of God to build her house and The Kingdom of God!

The first mother was selfish and easily deceived; when the serpent appeared to her she didn't question his message or his motives!

So Adam didn't apparently question Eve's (**strange**) request or her motives and disobeyed God!

On the other hand the mother of Jesus wasn't easily deceived; when an angel or messenger appeared to her she questioned his appearance.

She wondered why he was in her life what benefit was it to her future family and The Kingdom of God!

1 John 4:1 Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God....

Women have tremendous power to influence men and wives have even greater power to influence their homes for good or evil!

Mothers you are to point of departure—everything you want in your marriage, home and community comes through you!

You can raise good Godly children who are decent, loving obedient kind, thoughtful children.

Eve's first child was Cain who killed his little brother because he had the same spirit she had—she wanted to be more than what God intended!

Like his mama Cain was the first born, he already had the highest possible rank, position and status on earth!

Mary mother of Jesus didn't seek any more status or importance in the family, community or The Kingdom than God gave her!

She obviously knew she had an awesome role just being the mother of Jesus!

She was satisfied being a mother! The bible never says she became an apostle, prophet, pastor or teacher—in her mind it was enough to raise her children and prepare them to become whatever God ordains.

None of Jesus brothers believed in Him **until** after the resurrection they along with Mary were in the upper room and got filled with The Holy Ghost!
