

## Don't Ever Forget—God!

*KJV Psalm 103:1* <A Psalm of David.> *Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his holy name.*

*2 Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits:*

David went through hell before and after God raised him up to be king!

Time after time God delivered him until every one of his enemies was defeated!

*1 Chron 18:6....* “And the LORD gave victory to David wherever he went.”

So David declares he will bless The LORD with his soul (his life) and everything in his life will bless The Holy Name of God!

8. *Psalm 103:10* He has not treated us as we deserve for our sins or paid us back for our wrongs.
9. *Like as a father pitieth his children, so the LORD pitieth them that fear him.*
10. *He certainly knows what we are made of. He bears in mind that we are dust.*
