

The Blessing of The LORD!

KJV Genesis 39:2 And the LORD was with Joseph, and he was a prosperous man; and he was in the house of his master the Egyptian.

3 And his master saw that the LORD was with him, and that the LORD made all that he did to prosper in his hand.

4 And Joseph found grace in his sight, and he served him: and he made him overseer over his house, and all that he had he put into his hand.

*5 And it came to pass from the time that he had made him overseer in his house, and over all that he had, that the LORD blessed the Egyptian's house for Joseph's sake; and **the blessing of the LORD was upon all that he had in the house, and in the field.***

There are (3) characters mentioned in these scriptures:

The LORD, Joseph and Potiphar! Notice Joseph has a good relationship with ...let's say, both his bosses!

He is obedient to both God and Potiphar.

In fact, the Bible says The LORD was with Joseph and caused him to prosper, even while he was a servant in the house of Potiphar.

When his master Potiphar saw that God was with Joseph (**he lived a righteous godly life**) his master put Joseph in charge of everything he owned!

Even though Joseph was done wrong—he lived right!

Joseph never acted in rebellion to his master, he doesn't seem bitter and angry about being sold into slavery.

He is not refusing to work because of his dreams of being somebody great!

Joseph is not causing problems with other servants because he's living beneath his calling and his destiny!

Joseph is acting honorably causing his master to prosper!

Joseph decided to be a blessing!

Maybe this is why The Blessing of The Lord was upon Joseph, because in spite of his circumstances he made up his mind to be a blessing!

KJV Galatians 6:9 And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.

When we submit to God's plan no matter where we are God will favor us and bless us and people around us will see The Blessing of The Lord on our lives.

We will reap a harvest for the righteousness we've sown in the earth!

The Bible says **as soon as Potiphar** elevated Joseph God blessed everything Potiphar had!

Verse 5 says "*the LORD blessed the Egyptian's house for Joseph's sake; and the blessing of the LORD was upon all that he had in the house, and in the field.*"

The Blessing of The LORD was upon everything in his house because of Joseph!

Psalm 133:1 A song by David for going up to worship.

See how good and pleasant it is when brothers and sisters live together in harmony!

2 *It is like the precious oil on the head, running down on the beard, on the beard of Aaron, running down on the collar of his robes!*

3 *It is like the dew of Hermon, which falls on the mountains of Zion! For there the LORD has commanded the blessing, life forevermore.*

Joseph was submitted to God because he didn't rebel; when he found himself a servant of Potiphar, he submitted himself to Potiphar and because God was with Joseph Potiphar submitted all he had to Joseph!

Both Joseph & Potiphar submitted to the will of God and came into agreement!

Their agreement created a harmony that produced an anointing that caused The Blessing of The LORD to come upon them!

^{KJV} **Proverbs 10:22** *The blessing of the LORD, it maketh rich, and he addeth no sorrow with it.*

The Blessing of The LORD made Joseph wise, humble, productive and anointed!

Because Joseph knew he was blessed he didn't get bitter he got better!

The Blessing of The LORD made Potiphar aware, wise and prosperous!

The Blessing of The LORD kept Joseph from being a frustrated rebellious servant!

Because Joseph still believed The Dream he had **12 years earlier!**

Even when our lives don't look like what we dreamed, we must still act like we believe it!

^{KJV} **Proverbs 10:22** *The blessing of the LORD, it maketh rich, and he addeth no*

Everywhere Joseph went he was a blessing, he added to everyone, making their lives better and didn't make anyone sorry they met him!

Joseph was walking in the same blessing God placed on his **great grandfather Abraham.**

Genesis 12:2 And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing.
