

## The Yes of God!

**NIV 2 Corinthians 1:19** *For the Son of God, Jesus Christ, who was preached among you by me and Silas and Timothy, was not "Yes" and "No," but in him it has always been "Yes."*

**20** *For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ. And so through him the "Amen" is spoken by us to the glory of God.*

The reason Paul wrote this was some in Corinth began to question Paul's preaching because he'd promised to come see them and didn't.

Paul proposed a journey from Ephesus to Macedonia that would bring him to Corinth, but that didn't happen.

Paul changes his mind because he didn't want to come to them a second time with a heavy heart over sin and problems in their midst.

They were trying to get people focusing on Paul not keeping his word rather than focusing on The Word of God Paul preached!

➤ **Since Paul was preaching the truth about God, Paul's message was no less real and powerful than the God he preached!**

Paul said he means every word he preaches about God!

Paul is saying—**don't get it twisted!**

***"I might not do everything I say I'd like to do, but The God I told you about does!"***

Every Word God says will come to pass!

Every Word proclaimed about God's power and promises should be accepted and believed.

Paul didn't preach God was powerful one day and the next God can't do it!

Paul didn't preach God loves you and the next time God hates you!

Paul didn't preach God was a healer one day and the next God stopped healing!

Paul said **"I never preached a yes and no gospel to you"**!

I only preached to you ***"THE YES OF GOD"***!

*NIV John 14:6 Jesus said, "I am the way and the truth and the life.*

Jesus is The TRUTH and everything the bible says about Jesus is TRUE!

**Paul only preached Jesus:**

***"Is able to save to the uttermost!"*** (Heb 7:25)

Jesus can save murderers, child molesters, terrorists, white supremacists, gang bangers, abortionists, LGBTQIA and all in between.

***"After He saves us He able to keep us from falling."*** (Jude 24)

After Jesus brings us out those sinful lifestyles He can keep us from falling back into—lying, cheating, stealing, murdering, drugging, fornicating and any other sin.

***"He promised never to leave or abandon us"*** (Heb 13:5)

Because once we let Jesus into our lives He never leaves us!  
He is there to pull us out and raise us up when we repent.

***"Jesus promised He'd let nothing come between His love for us"***  
(Rom 8:35)

If we happen to get thrown into a fiery situation: **He is able to deliver!**

***"Our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and he will deliver us out of your hand, O king.*** (Dan 3:17)

***"And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work."*** (2 Corinthians 9:8)

***"Abraham believed God was able to raise Isaac from the dead!"***  
(Heb 11:19)

***"Is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us."***

***Is anything too hard for the LORD?*** (Genesis 18:14)

If you believe in the **"Yes of God"** then--

***"Have faith in God"*** (Mark 11:22)

Everything God promises can be found in the reality of Christ Jesus!

**❖ Jesus Christ is the fulfillment of All The Promises of God!**

Just as Jesus Christ is real, so too is everything God promises!

Just as Jesus came to earth in the flesh, your promise is coming!

Just as Jesus is real, your breakthrough is real!

**People may not have the power to do everything they say—but the God I preach about HAS ALL POWER!**

*KJV Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.*

Jesus can still do everything He's ever done—God promises that!

If He ever did something once it's not a **maybe** He can do it again, it's a **yes** that He can do it again!

*ESV Numbers 23:19 God is not man, that he should lie, or a son of man, that he should change his mind. Has he said, and will he not do it? Or has he spoken, and will he not fulfill it?*

God is **not** like the apostle Paul, God is **not** like TD Jakes, Rod Parsley, James Logan or any other man.

We are all trying to be like Him! So when you see the shortcomings of any believer don't think for one minute they're found in Christ!

For Pilate upon judging Jesus had to say *"I find no fault in this man!"*
