

When Kings Go to Battle!

KJV Psalm 30:1 <A Psalm and Song at the dedication of the (THE TEMPLE) house of David.> *I will extol thee, O LORD; for thou hast lifted me up, and hast not made my foes to rejoice over me.*

5 For his anger endureth but a moment; in his favour is life: weeping may endure for a night, but joy cometh in the morning.

In the mind of the biblical Jew the day begins in the evening and ends in the morning just as the first days did.

KJV Genesis 1:5 *And God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And the evening and the morning were the first day.*

Weeping begins and endures during the night season! We are conceived at night, born out of the darkness of the womb into the marvelous light of day. Night is associated with secrecy, obscurity and danger.

So too are we born again from the darkness of sin into the light of The kingdom of God and become children of light *ESV Ephesians 5:8* *for at one time you were darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light.*

ESV Proverbs 4:18 *But the path of the righteous is like the light of dawn, which shines brighter and brighter until full day.*

As we grow in The LORD we gain wisdom, knowledge and revelation and the purpose of our lives becomes clearer and more glorious.

As we go from one level of faith to the next we also go from one level of glory to the next! **We use faith to fight through night seasons in life!**

ESV 2 Corinthians 3:18 *And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another.*

It is our destiny as Sons of God, kings and priests to walk in the light and **wage warfare on the kingdom of darkness.**

KJV 1 Peter 2:9 *But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation...*

- ❖ **We are a kingdom of king/priests; we war as priests and reign as kings. As priests we die to self; as kings we reign over others.**

NIV Genesis 14:17 After Abram returned from defeating Kedorlaomer and the (3) kings allied with him, the king of Sodom came out to meet him in the Valley of Shaveh (the kings valley).

Abraham our father in the faith used his faith to defeat kings!

KJV 2 Samuel 11:1 And it came to pass, after the year was expired, at the time when kings go forth to battle, that David sent Joab, and his servants with him, and all Israel; and they destroyed the children of Ammon, and besieged Rabbah. But David tarried still at Jerusalem.

In ancient times people were restricted from doing certain activities because of the climate.

In Palestine there were basically **two seasons** wet (fall/winter) and dry (spring/summer)!

So it was during the dry season in the spring after the latter rains that kings went to battle.

Spring time is also the time of **The Passover!**

The time when God (The King of Glory) came down and did battle with the **gods** (king) of Egypt defeated them and setting His people free!

And bringing them into The Promised Land!

So Jesus Christ had to suffer, die and be resurrected in the spring—for it's the time when kings go to battle.

KJV Colossians 2:15 And having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it.

Jesus The King of kings fought defeated the forces of darkness and took the spoils of victory!

In Palestine, the harvest didn't begin till after the Passover, which was fixed on the 14th of the month Nisan, which begins in March and extends into April.

The people couldn't bring their (offerings) first fruits to The LORD until after the harvest just before Pentecost.

Because it was at **Pentecost**, **the first fruits** of all the harvest were carried to the temple, and waved before the Lord. See [Leviticus 23:11](#)

Jesus Christ King of kings and LORD of lords is the game changer!

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So again it was during the dry season in the spring after the latter rains that kings went to battle.

We see that king David stayed home in his palace relaxing and enjoying himself when he should have been on the battle field.

Every member of this church who has connected with Jesus Christ and the vision of this ministry should be going to battle with the rest of the kings (sons of God).

To remain home and not come to church, fasting, praying, serving and worshipping is remaining out of the battle.

When David did this he got distracted and caught up in a sin that cost the life of his **first fruit** (son) of Bathsheba.

In the spring after the latter rain the crops are ripe and ready for harvest!

So it's the kings who go the battle that receive the spoils of victory— they take the crops, the livestock, the land, the people and all the wealth back to their kingdoms and share it with their citizens.

KJV 1 Chronicles 26:27 Out of the spoils won in battles did they dedicate to maintain the house of the LORD.

No battles, no victories, no victories, no spoils, and no spoils what do we use to build The Kingdom of God?

KJV 1 Corinthians 15:57 But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.
