

## Do It Again Lord, Do It Again!

*KJV Genesis 8:1* And **God remembered** Noah, and every living thing, and all the cattle that was with him in the ark: and God made a wind to pass over the earth, and the waters asswaged;

*KJV Genesis 30:22* And **God remembered** Rachel, and God hearkened to her, and opened her womb.

*KJV Exodus 2:24* And God heard their groaning, and **God remembered** his covenant with Abraham, with Isaac, and with Jacob.

**25** And God looked upon the children of Israel, and God had respect unto them.

**In the mind of the religious Jew time is cyclical and events are destined to repeat themselves and God desires to do what He has done before.**

*KJV Ecclesiastes 1:9* The thing that hath been, it is that which shall be; and that which is done is that which shall be done: and there is no new thing under the sun.

Most of you will remember last month when I taught two important messages: “*When it’s Your Turn it’s Your Time*” and “*This is a Kairos Moment.*”

Both messages dealt with time from a biblical prophetic perspective!

**The Church is not simply a group of people married to Christ; The Body of Christ is a prophetic people!**

**Our past, present and future have all been predetermined by God!**

*KJV Romans 8:29* For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren.

**God’s purpose in Christ is to make us over again and bring us back to our original place in Him!**

This is a prophetic cycle; mankind had a downward spiral through sin!

Through Christ Jesus we that are saved are now in an upward spiral!

As we begin a New Year (**Rosh Hashana**) today we have completed an annual cycle and begin a new one!

Day 1 of a new year will start all over again, what has been will be again!

*KJV Ecclesiastes 3:15 That which hath been is now; and that which is to be hath already been; and God **requireth** that which is past.*

There are **two** words in scripture that describe this phenomenon for believers the prophetic people of God: **remember** and **testimony!**

We began by reading **Gen 8:1, 30:22 & Ex 2:24-25**, they all said God **remember** Noah, Rachel and Abraham.

When God remembers us, He brings us full circle, back into view, we become (**priority**) the apple of His eye. (Psalm 17:8, Zec 2:8)

And God performs the things He promised!

Our **holy** worship, prayer and praise gets God's attention keeping us the apple of His eye and reminds Him of his promises to us!

*KJV Isaiah 43:26 Put me in remembrance: let us plead together: declare thou, that thou mayest be justified.*

- God requires us to **remind** Him of his Word so He can do it again!

**Reading, studying and praying** God's Word in not some ego trip God is on, no! God wants to do for us what He's done for others, so He requires us to remind Him!

**Ecclesiastes 3:15** says God **requires** what has happened!

**Require** is the Hebrew word **baqash** (bawkash) meaning "seeking to find, to desire and demand."

When Asa king of Judah was surrounded and outnumbered, Hanani the seer came to him and said:

This isn't anything new to God, remember when the Ethiopians and Lubims outnumbered you less than 30 years ago and God defeats them.

*2 Chronicles 16:9 For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to shew himself strong in the behalf of them whose heart is perfect toward him. Herein thou hast done foolishly: therefore from henceforth thou shalt have wars.*

God is looking for people who will remind Him of what He has already done and **believe Him to do it again!**

God demands that we seek Him to do somethings He has already done making His actions a priority over all others!

*ESV Isaiah 55:10 "For as the rain and the snow come down from heaven and do not return there but water the earth, making it bring forth and sprout, giving seed to the sower and bread to the eater, **It** so shall my word be that goes out from my mouth; it shall not return to me empty, but it shall accomplish that which I purpose, and shall succeed in the thing for which I sent it.*

God is not just talking about the reproductive power of water, seed and soil. He's talking about the repetitive cycles of seasons that repeat themselves in the earth.

*Genesis 8:22 As long as the earth exists, planting and harvesting, cold and heat, summer and winter, day and night will never stop."*

The mystery is this, **God is guaranteed to do what He has already done!**

**If you want God to do something, find out what He has already done and ask Him to do it again!**

- **Remember** means to "recall or call back to the now."

We remember things that are a **priority** in our lives!

- **Testimony** means "witness"! A person who testifies is the proof that something happened.

When we **testify** of God's working in our lives, we not only are the proof that it happened, we **release the power** for it to happen again!

One of the thieves on the cross who honored Jesus for who he was, said "Lord, remember me when thou comest into thy kingdom."

*KJV Luke 23:43 And Jesus said unto him, **Verily I say unto thee, To day shalt thou be with me in paradise.***

He asked Jesus to **remember** him! To keep him as an apple of His eye, in the forefront of Jesus mind, **as a priority!**

Jesus said **this day** you will be with me in paradise!

That thief's life was changed that very day!
