

Fresh Oil New Wine Part 3

KJV Isaiah 65:8 Thus saith the LORD, As the new wine is found in the cluster, and one saith, destroy it not; for a blessing is in it: so will I do for my servants' sakes, that I may not destroy them all.

A **cluster** is defined as a number of similar things growing naturally together!

New Wine is the first drippings of freshly picked grapes; new wine was also called Sweet Wine; it was not as potent as mature wine and because of its sweetness more of it had to be consumed to get drunk.

Besides the grapes part of the **cluster** is the **tendrils** and the **peduncles** they're not used to make the wine but are important.

The **tendrils** is the slender coiling part of the plant that wraps around and clings to another object or plant for support.

The **peduncle** is the stalk that holds the fruit together.

In a vineyard there are vines scattered among the plants that have no fruit and suddenly you find a cluster.

Among the Rabbi's and older men, the **old wine** was more mellow!

As time passes the old wine turns to **vinegar** and the new wine mellows.

The **New Wine** of the Holy Spirit in the last days will be found where the saints are unified, love God, each other and are growing together in the knowledge and grace of God!

The **Old Wine** folks are walking around frustrated, uncooperative and bitter; they won't work together and accomplish Kingdom work because they're bitter from the **vinegar** they drink instead of **new wine**.

God is **unifying, maturing and glorifying** His Church! (Eph 5:27)

God is bringing **The True Vine** together because the blessing is in the cluster, not the scatter disjointed grapes that grow wild and free.

You see it's the **tendrils** and **peduncle** that **supports** and **strengthens** the vine so it can produce clusters.

KJV Ephesians 4:3 Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

We can no longer afford to exist as **separate, individual grapes** on the Vine, the best grapes grow in clusters.

KJV Isaiah 65:8 Thus saith the LORD, As the new wine is found in the cluster, and one saith, destroy it not; for a blessing is in it:

There is a tremendous blessing in **worshipping, praying, praising, serving and persevering together!**

Because as we grow and mature together we endure the same storms and same victories together.

We realize how much we can accomplish together, how much we need each other!

Grapes clustered tightly together support and stabilize one another making it harder to be pulled off the vine, drop off and die!

Ecclesiastes 4:9 Two are better than one; because they have a good reward for their labour.

10 For if they fall, one will lift up his fellow. But woe to him who is alone when he falls and has not another to lift him up!

11 Again, if two lie together, then they have heat: but how can one be warm alone?

12 Though one may be overpowered, two can defend themselves. A cord of three strands is not quickly broken.

Again a **cluster** is defined as *a number of similar things growing naturally together.*

In **Ephesians 4** Paul tells us Jesus gave the Five-fold ministry (**doma**) gifts to help care for the Vine, keeping the grapes together so they can grow up (mature), not remain children pulled away by every new doctrine.

Teaching every part how they fit together and supply strength and anointings to each other so The Body can build itself up in love.

The Cluster provides a fresh anointing for the next generation!
