

Get Ready for Jesus Part 4 The Lord is Coming!

KJV Jude 1:14 And Enoch also, the seventh from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, Behold, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of his saints, 15 To execute judgment upon all, and to convince all that are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have ungodly committed, and of all their hard speeches which ungodly sinners have spoken against him.

Enoch said The LORD is **coming** with ten thousands (an innumerable multitude) of His saints to execute judgment on the ungodly.

From the beginning of time God revealed His plan of coming back for (His Bride) the righteous and punishing the wicked!

1 Thessalonians 4:14 For since we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so, through Jesus, God will bring with him those who have fallen asleep.

15 For this we declare to you by a word from the Lord, that we who are alive, who are left until the coming of the Lord, will not precede those who have fallen asleep.

16 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:

*17 Then we which are alive and remain shall be **caught up** together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.*

Caught up (harpadzo) means to be snatched up and carried off!

What I want you to understand is there's a difference between **The Rapture and The Second Coming!**

Enoch is prophesying about the **Second Coming** when Christ sets up His Kingdom!

Paul is talking about **The Rapture**, the collection of the saints!

At **The Rapture** Jesus will descend from heaven and the **saints** will **meet Him in the air** (those dead and alive).

The church will go off to The Marriage Supper of The Lamb (Rev 19) after God's Wrath is poured out (Rev 17:18)

I will spend a good amount of time explaining this to you next time because understanding **marriage** from God's perspective is key to understanding The Rapture and The Second Coming of Christ!

At The Second Coming the church comes back to earth with Christ to wage war against the ungodly this is called The Battle of Armageddon.

KJV Revelation 17:14 These shall make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb shall overcome them: for he is Lord of lords, and King of kings: and they that are with him are called, and **chosen, and faithful.**

KJV 1 Corinthians 15:51 Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,
52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

[I believe this occurs before The Great Tribulation!](#)

Some of you say, what difference does it make, Pretrib, Midtrib or Posttrib?

If you're expecting someone to pick you up and take you to a very important appointment, when they're coming is extremely important.

KJV 2 Timothy 4:8 Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing.

KJV Revelation 22:12 And, behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be.

When Jesus comes back, He's bringing our reward with Him!

When Jesus comes back, we will see and experience His glory!

KJV Matthew 24:37 But as the days of Noe were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.

38 For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark,

39 And knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.

We've spoken before on The Days of Noah and how much the times and events of today mirror Noah's Day.

Noah preached for 100 years while building The Ark and no one believed him until the flood came.

40 Then shall two be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left.

41 Two women shall be grinding at the mill; the one shall be taken, and the other left.

42 Watch therefore: for ye know not what hour your Lord doth come.

Jesus tells us to watch, pay special attention to the times so you'll be **Ready for Jesus** and won't get left behind!

KJV Revelation 3:10 Because thou hast kept the word of my patience, I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth.

Jesus says these words to **The Church of Philadelphia!**

Because they obeyed **The Word** and endured the tests and trials of this world, they will be kept from the hour of testing that's coming to the whole world.

KJV Revelation 3:11 Behold, I come quickly: hold that fast which thou hast, that no man take thy crown.

KJV Revelation 22:7 Behold, I come quickly: blessed is he that keepeth the sayings of the prophecy of this book.

Revelation 22:12 And, behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be.

KJV Revelation 22:20 He which testifieth these things saith, Surely I come quickly. Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus.

Jesus says numerous times **"Behold, I Come Quickly"**!

Basically, Jesus is saying, **Get Ready When I Make up My Mind to Come Its Going to Happen Quickly and Suddenly!**

The ONLY warning you will have is what I've already given you!

If you're **confused or focused on other things**, you'll miss Him!

If you're **NOT ready**, you will left behind for **The Great Tribulation and The Day of God Wrath on the earth!**
