

The Prophetic Atmosphere of The Last Days Part 2!

KJV Acts 2:17 And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall **see visions**, and your old men shall **dream dreams**:

18 And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy:

The apostle Peter says the last days will be characterized by **Prophecy, Visions and Dreams**, all of which are **seen or perceived**.

Basically, **Spiritual sight** will increase in **The Last Days!**

Prophecy and Spiritual Sight are synonymous:

KJV 1 Samuel 9:9 (Beforetime in Israel, when a man went to enquire of God, thus he spake, Come, and let us go to the seer: for he that is now called a Prophet was beforetime called a Seer.)

Ra'ah or **Seer** means to perceive, inspect, discern or have a vision!

Again, this is all in the **realm of the prophetic**, but this kind of seeing is **not** always with the natural eyes.

KJV Matthew 5:8 **Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God.**

The best way to approach defining a pure heart is to look at what Jesus said the opposite of a pure heart was.

Pharisees, practiced outward purity, by wearing religious garments, sitting in special seats and saying special prayers while their hearts were full of corruption and defilement.

In short, they were **pretenders, actors or hypocrites** as the KJ says!

Psalm 51:6 Behold, thou desirest truth in the inward parts..!

King David says God desires **truth** in the **inward parts** and then God can teach us **wisdom!**

John 16:13 **Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.**

Without a **pure heart** we cannot **see** things clearly, nor **perceive** and **understand God** plainly, what He's doing in our lives, what He's up to in the world or what's coming!

KJV Matthew 12:34 O generation of vipers, how can ye, being evil, speak good things? for out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh.

Jesus tells us what's in our heart comes out of our mouths!

KJV Matthew 13:15 For this people's heart is waxed gross, and their ears are dull of hearing, and their eyes they have closed; lest at any time they should see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and should understand with their heart, and should be converted, and I should heal them.

The heart is the center of our spiritual life, it's that which influences the mind!

If it becomes **dull** it's **unable to hear clearly and receive from God!**

Jesus says when a person becomes **closed minded**, it becomes hard for them to hear, see and understand spiritually things.

Their hearts are **not** pure and therefore they **cannot see (perceive) God.**

If hearts become hard, (impure and their minds are closed) how will they be able to see **visions, dreams & prophecy** from The LORD?

❖ **Again, we see with our heart!** Tell your neighbor, see me with your heart!

KJV Matthew 5:8 Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God.

Proverbs 4:23 Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life.

NAS Luk 6:45 "The good man out of the good treasure of his heart brings forth what is good; and the evil man out of the evil treasure brings forth what is evil; for his mouth speaks from that which fills his heart.

Shall see God—This is a Hebraism, which signifies, possess God, enjoy his felicity (presence): as seeing a thing, was used among the Hebrews for possessing it.

The pure in heart can easily see, perceive and receive prophetic visions, dreams and insight from God!

KJV Titus 1:15 To the pure, all things are pure, but to the defiled and unbelieving, nothing is pure; but both their minds and their consciences are defiled.

NAS Rom 14:14 I know and am convinced in the Lord Jesus that nothing is unclean in itself; but to him who thinks anything to be unclean, to him it is unclean.

Since we see with our hearts, an unclean heart cannot perceive the clean holy thoughts and visions of God Almighty!

Remember in **2 kings 6:16-17** Elisha prayed for God to open the spiritual eyes of his servant so he could see the army of God.

KJV Psalm 6:7 Mine eye is consumed because of grief; it waxeth old because of all mine enemies.

Elisha's servant couldn't see (perceive) what was really happening because of (**fear**) the enemies surrounding him.

2 Kings 6:16 And he answered, Fear not: for they that be with us are more than they that be with them.

When **fear** which is one of the great contaminants of the **heart** is removed, we can see more clearly what God is doing in our lives.

Will see God, perceive His ways, movements as well as see Visions, Dreams and prophecy!

Peter said it will be **upon God's servants and handmaids**, those whose hearts are after nothing but pleasing The LORD!
