

Good Things Happening in The Last Days

KJV Isaiah 2:2 And it shall come to pass in the last days, that the mountain of the LORD'S house shall be established in the top of the mountains, and shall be exalted above the hills; and all nations shall flow unto it.

The prophet Isaiah under the inspiration of The Holy Spirit says in The Last Days the glory of God's Kingdom will be seen above all kingdoms and all people will gravitate to it!

Micah 4:1 And it will come about in the last days That the mountain of the house of the LORD Will be established as the chief of the mountains. It will be raised above the hills, And the peoples will stream to it.

Isaiah and Micah were contemporaries prophesying during the same time period!

Isaiah prophesied to noblemen and kings, while **Micah** prophesied to common ordinary people.

As you might imagine the upper-class had a harder time receiving the idea God was establishing His Kingdom; it meant a change in their status and lifestyle.

It was easier for **Micah** who understood the problems and concerns of common folk. His prophecy about a new kingdom being established was welcomed and seen as **Good News!**

Even today there are many who don't want God's Kingdom established on earth because they like the way things are!

Many are **benefiting** from the kingdoms (systems, businesses) of man.

Mark 10: 23 Jesus looked around and said to his disciples, "How hard it will be for rich people to enter the kingdom of God!"

24 And the disciples were astonished at his words. But Jesus answereth again, and saith unto them, Children, how hard is it for them that trust in riches to enter into the kingdom of God!

25 It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich person to enter the kingdom of God.

Why did Jesus say this?

Because wealthy people can easily begin to trust in their riches!

Yet there is Good News for both rich and poor in The Last Days!

Acts 2:17 And it shall be in the last days, God says, That I will pour forth of My Spirit upon all mankind; And your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, And your young men shall see visions, And your old men shall dream dreams;

God is pouring out His Spirit on **all flesh**, rich and poor, sons and daughters, men and women!

The **rich** will be **saved filled, led, and used** by Holy Spirit.

They will be transformed by the renewing of their minds and start using their wealth and power to advance the **influence of The King** rather than their own agendas.

They will heed the voice of the **Isaiah's** of the day looking past their personal desires to the desires of King Jesus.

They will transfer much of their wealth to the **Nehemiah's and Ezra's** of the day who are building & rebuilding The Kingdom of God.

Like **Isaiah** they know how to convince their wealthy friends to use their resources for the glory of God.

Like **Micah** they understand the needs and concerns of the common people.

The **Joseph's** will come into their inheritance and rescue many from famine and save the lives of many people.

The **Zacchaeus'** will receive Jesus into their hearts and houses, confess their sins have a change of heart and **give back the** wealth they cheated from the poor and restore 4 times what they stole from anyone.

Acts 2:17 And it shall be in the last days, God says, That I will pour forth of My Spirit upon all mankind; And your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, And your young men shall see visions, And your old men shall dream dreams.

During **The Last Days** there will be things happening that could only happen by The Holy Spirit!

The world won't know how to explain it, only by The Power of The Holy Ghost will these **GOOD THINGS HAPPEN!**

Zerubbabel was an aristocrat, from a wealthy family taken into Babylonian slavery. He became governor of Judea and was assigned to rebuild the temple of The Lord and reestablish the Kingdom.

He was opposed so strongly Zerubbabel was only able to lay the foundation, it took 15 years for the temple to be completed.

No matter what Zerubbabel tried it fell short until The Holy Spirit moved, his marching, protesting, & political posturing had little effect.

- It took a **strong move of The Spirit** to help Zerubbabel finish!

The LORD said to him **Zech 4:6-7**, "*You won't succeed by might or by power, but by my Spirit, says the LORD of Armies.*"

7 Who are you, O great mountain? Before Zerubbabel you shall become a plain. And he shall bring forward the top stone amid shouts of 'Grace, grace to it!'"

*^{KJV} Isaiah 2:2 And it shall come to pass in the last days, that the **mountain** of the LORD'S house shall be established in the top of the **mountains**, and shall be exalted above the hills; and all nations shall flow unto it.*

Mountains hold a special place in scripture, they represent places, of protection, places of worship, and barren lonely places.

Here in Isaiah **mountains** represent kingdoms, both earthly and heavenly, worldly, and divine, temporary, and eternal.

The mountain of The LORD's House is God's eternal Kingdom; hence it's referred to as a **single mountain**.

The top of the mountains refers to the many kingdoms of man on earth! God is saying there's coming a time, **in The Last Days** when The Kingdom of God will be clearly and powerfully established above all the kingdoms of this world and all people groups will flow to it and behold its glory!

In The Last Days God's Kingdom will take center stage over all other **kingdoms**.

People will bring their wealth from all over the world adding to the glory of The Kingdom.

Proverbs 10:15 The rich person's wealth is his strong city. Poverty ruins the poor.

Pro 14:20 The poor is hated even by his neighbor, but those who love the rich are many.

During The Last Days wealth transfer, the hated, disrespected, and rejected will become the loved, and influential.

Proverbs 13:22 A good man leaveth an inheritance to his children's children: and **the wealth of the sinner is laid up for the just**.

Ecclesiastes 2:26 God gives wisdom, knowledge, and joy to anyone who pleases him. But to the person who continues to sin, he gives the job of gathering and collecting wealth. The sinner must turn his wealth over to the person who pleases God.

In The Last Days all nations (ethnic groups) will support The Gospel and help build The Kingdom of God!

Sinners will turn their wealth over to the righteous so the righteous can glorify God and His Kingdom!
