

What it Means to Be Saved!

KJV Numbers 10:9 And if ye go to war in your land against the enemy that oppresseth you, then ye shall blow an alarm with the trumpets; and ye shall be remembered before the LORD your God, and ye shall be saved from your enemies.

This is the first mention of God promising to **save His people!**

To be **saved** in the Biblical sense means to be **rescued and liberated!**

Salvation & redemption are related.

To truly understand God's intentions, we must understand types, metaphors, symbols, parables and signs.

In **Num 10:2** God tells Moses to make **two trumpets of silver**. One for calling the people together and one for sending the people out.

- **Silver is a metaphor and symbolic of redemption!**

Redemption is buying something back and reclaiming it as yours!

God says when **He hears** the **silver trumpet blown**, He will remember His people **rescue** and **liberate** them.

❖ **Notice God doesn't respond until they blow the trumpet!**

God says no matter what you're going through, no matter how hard it is and how bad it gets, if you don't **blow the trumpet**, I don't know you want My help!

God says I'll only know you want to be saved, when you blow The trumpet!

Trumpets weren't originally musical instruments; they were used to make a sound to get people's attention!

They were a summons to gather, to move out as a company, a summons of an attack and announced the time of worship.

In The New Testament trumpets point to Christ!

His salvation, healing and deliverance!

At the End Time it announces the gathering of the saints to Christ!

- The **trumpet** is also synonymous with the **mouth!**

KJV Isaiah 58:1 Cry aloud, spare not, lift up thy voice like a trumpet, and shew my people their transgression, and the house of Jacob their sins.

When we raise our voices, they become like trumpets and gets attention!

The phrase “**lift up your voice**” means to make a loud noticeable sound!

This is not the time for soft speech, it’s time to lift our voices!

Again, trumpets didn’t give off pleasing sounds, they were attention getters, (God is using our President as an attention getter, the question is how we interpret the sounds? **May The Lord give you understanding**)

❖ **Repentance is blowing the trumpet, asking God to save us!**

When people are desperate and need rescuing, they lift up their voice and cry loud!

Remember God can see us under attack but won’t intervene until we **blow the trumpet** (ask for help)!

KJV Romans 10:9 That **if** thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.

10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

KJV Romans 10:13 For **whosoever** shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

There’s a **common enemy** out here called **Corona Virus**, we need to **Blow The Trumpet (repent)** as one voice, making one sound!

The only prayer needed in this hour is **LORD forgive us on our sins, cleanse us from all unrighteousness and rescue us from our enemies!**

Numbers 10:9 And if ye go to war in your land against the enemy that oppresseth you, then ye shall blow an alarm with the trumpets; and ye shall **be remembered before the LORD** your God, and ye shall be saved from your enemies.

Our prayer of repentance and forgiveness causes God to remember His great and precious promises!

Number 10 tells us **How to be saved if we want to be saved, and what it means to be saved!**

KJV Acts 2:17 And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams:

18 And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy:

19 And I will shew wonders in heaven above, and signs in the earth beneath; blood, and fire, and vapour of smoke:

20 The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before that great and notable day of the Lord come:

*21 And it shall come to pass, that **whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved.***

Whoever lifts their voice and cries out to Jesus will be saved!

In *John 10:9* Jesus says, *I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture.*

KJV Psalm 50:15 *And call upon me in the day of trouble: I will deliver thee, and thou shalt glorify me.*

Jeremiah 33:3 *Call to me and I will answer you, and will tell you great and hidden things that you have not known.*

We must cry out to God to show us the mystery behind this virus so we can pool our considerable resources and defeat this enemy!

Only those who called on Him first will be called upon in The End!

Calling on Jesus to save us prepares us for **The Last Trumpet!**

KJV 1 Corinthians 15:51 *Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,*

*52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, **at the last trump**: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.*

Those **born from above** are The Bride of Christ and we will be gathered together with Him before The Great and Terrible Day of The Lord!

When we hear **The Last Trumpet** sound, we will be gathered together and meet Him in the air and forever be with The LORD!

This is **Ultimately** what it **means to be saved!**

If you want to be saved, the **only** way is to lift your voice like a trumpet and call on The Name of The Lord, Jesus Christ!

Someone who sees you're in trouble and rescues you is a **Hero**, someone who gives their life to rescue you is your **Savior!**
