

Whose Report Will You Believe Part 2

KJV Isaiah 53:1 Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the LORD revealed?

Isaiah asks who will believe his (report) prophecy about the coming Messiah!

God revealed The Coming of Christ to Isaiah and his job was to **report** (proclaim, foretell, and declare) what heard from God!

Like then, today many are **looking for salvation from everywhere but God!**

I came to proclaim that salvation is already here, deliverance is already here, healing is already here!

It's not and never has been in a government, an organization, or mans abilities—but it's always been in Jesus!

People have forgotten, ignored or rejected The Savior!

Psalm 3:8 Salvation belongeth unto the LORD: thy blessing is upon thy people. Selah.

Salvation is help, deliverance, rescue, and preservation from all enemies, foreign or domestic, natural, spiritual, or biological!

Belong means “*to go along with*”! salvation goes along with God, when you get God you get salvation and without God there is no salvation!

When God is in the picture, salvation is either in the forefront or the background! **It's either happening or it's on the way!**

Belong also means “*owner of*”! The LORD owns salvation, it belongs to Him; He does what He wants with it and declares it's for His people!

If God is not in it there can be no salvation!

It's **God** alone who saves, heals, and rescues! No one else!

Salvation **comes** from God and salvation **continues** with God!

In other words, The One who **saves** us **keeps** us saved or we can be captured again by the same enemy!

This my friends is GOOD NEWS!

This is why God calls and anoints people to tell it!

Let's think about what we've just learned:

Since salvation belongs to The LORD, He is the sole **owner** and **provider** of salvation.

Whenever we need to be rescued from anything at all, any enemy whatsoever. We just look to Jehovah God!

Every mechanism of deliverance **must** come through Him.

KJV Psalm 121:1 <A Song of degrees.> I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills, from whence cometh my help.

2 My help cometh from the LORD, which made heaven and earth.

3 He will not suffer thy foot to be moved: he that keepeth thee will not slumber.

The song writer says he knows where his **help comes from**, it comes from **Jehovah, The Self-Existent God that keeps His promises!**

Since his **help** come from The LORD **he looks** to The LORD!

This is Good News because when trouble breaks out you already know where to look and who will help—God Almighty!

*KJV Psalm 20:7 Some trust in chariots, and some in horses: **but we will remember the name of the LORD our God.***

Chariots and horses represent man's abilities!

David said **some** trust in man's abilities, what man can do!

Some think man has the answers or will figure it out!

David said not me and not God's people, **we will trust** in the **name of The LORD (Jehovah, The Self-Existent God who keeps His promises)**

God's Name and His reputation are unmatched, He has never broken a promise.

When He promised to SAVE us He has and will again!

God saves everyone who **calls upon His Name!**

This is The GOSPEL! This is THE GOOD NEWS!

I'm **not called to tell you things are bad and getting worse—the world does a good job of that!**

I'm **not anointed to tell you some might not make it through this—the world will do that!**

I'm called and anointed to tell you THE GOOD NEWS!

That Jehovah is our God!

That Salvation belongs to The LORD!

I'm called to tell you to reject fear and embrace faith!

I'm anointed to tell you by **faith our ancestors obtained a **good report!****

Hebrews 11:5 By faith Enoch was taken up so that he should not see death, and he was not found, because God had taken him. Now before he was taken he was commended as having pleased God.

Hebrews 11:6 But without faith it is impossible to please **God!**

By Faith Noah built an Ark having **never seen rain!**

By Faith Abraham followed God **not knowing where he was going!**

By faith Jacob **worshipped God & blessed his sons while he was dying!**

Hebrews 11:32 What more should I say? I don't have enough time to tell you about Gideon, Barak, Samson, Jephthah, David, Samuel, and the prophets.

33 who through faith conquered kingdoms, enforced justice, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions,

34 put out raging fires, and escaped death. They found strength when they were weak They were powerful in battle and put foreign armies to flight.

35 Women received their loved ones back from the dead. Other believers were brutally tortured but refused to be released so that they might rise again to a better life.

The Good News is for thousands of years people who believed that God is a Savior have been **rescued** from every type of **danger** there is, **even death!**

^{KJV} Hebrews 10:38 Now the just shall live by faith: but if any man draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him.

39 But we are not of those who shrink back and are destroyed, but of those who have faith and preserve their souls.

Matthew 10:28 And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather fear him who can destroy both soul and body in hell.

If we become **more fearful** of what can kill our bodies than who can destroy our souls, we have **lost the faith!**

If we become **more** fearful of loosing our **physical life** than our **soul**, we will lose both in hell!
